College Incentives for NH Scholars

Nearly all graduating New Hampshire Scholars seniors immediately enroll in postsecondary education. Less than **55%** however, attended college in-state. While this matches or exceeds the state average, many institutions would like to recognize NH Scholars students for challenging themselves by providing application fee waivers. We encourage students to use these fee waivers responsibly, thus researching the college to ensure proper fit. Students should be applying to colleges that are a good fit - not solely because it's free. Thank you.

Southern New Hampshire University – Application fee waivers will be distributed to the high schools through the NH Scholars office. Students applying at <u>www.commonapp.org</u> should select 'fee waiver' option and mail in their waiver to SNHU separately.
