RELATIONS WITH POLICE AUTHORITIES

Statement of Purpose

It is the purpose of this policy to prescribe the manner in which police interrogations and investigations are to be handled by school and law enforcement officials.

Statement of Policy

It is the intention of the school district and the local police departments to work in a joint cooperative effort to provide a safe and healthy school environment for students, staffs, and visitors while on school district properties. This effort will be carried out in compliance with New Hampshire RSA 193-D, Safe School Zones, as amended, and the Memorandum of Understanding signed by the district and both local police departments.

This policy is not intended to govern the actions of the School Resource officer (SRO) while he/she is acting as a member of the school staff.

When law enforcement officials find it necessary to interview students during the school day, they will contact the student only through the principal's office. The school officials will bring the student to the office to meet the law enforcement officer. All interviews with students at school by officers of the law will be conducted in a private office with the principal, counselor, or teacher present. The officer of the law will notify the parent of the interview, prior to meeting with the student.

In the event it becomes necessary to interview the student away from school, the parents will be notified of the time and place of the interview. The student will be accompanied to and from the place of interview by either the parents or a member of the school staff.
