Scholarship Application

Please remember that even if an application uses the "General Common Application," which requires an essay, there may be additional, **specific** requirements for the application. It is your responsibility to make sure your applications are received on time and complete. **Pay close attention to all the requirements. If you are unsure, ask!**

Scholarship Application Attachments

Except for transcripts (which include GPA, class rank and SAT scores), students are responsible for including all other information that is required with their applications (recommendations, references, college acceptance letters, essays, financial forms, etc.).

Notification of Award

Most scholarships are awarded at the academic awards night in early June, unless otherwise indicated.

Disbursement of Scholarship Funds

Most of the scholarships are awarded directly to the college after successful completion of the first semester, unless otherwise indicated. Specific information will be given to the award recipient.
