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Quilted Oval Placemats

Create:

Materials: I was able to easily attach the double fold bias tape around the perimeter of the placemats, overlapping the start and finish points correctly.

Craftsmanship: The bias tape was correctly hand sewn to the reverse side of each placemat. Stitching is almost invisible and where the bias tape overlaps the connection appears smooth and flat.

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Octagonal Placemats

Perform:

Proportion: Wonder – Under and Thermolam Plus were correctly secured to the placemat fabric and trimmed.

Perform:

Craftsmanship: Placemat layers were pinned together and sewn around the perimeter an even ½ inch from the edge. I used the backstitching technique where I began and ended the stitching and cut all the corners diagonally before turning the each placemat to the right side.

Craftsmanship: Placemat seams were rolled to the end, resulting in a clean edge around the exterior. The opening was pinned in place in preparation for top stitching.

Perform:

Craftsmanship: each placemat was ironed resulting in smooth even sides. There are no bumps or bubbles. The top stitching around each placemat is even and secures both fabrics together.
