This will be posted to the SAU website once approved by the Committee and School Board.

4. <u>Updates on K-5 Literacy Program</u> – Ms. Desrochers said the K-5 teachers spent time during the fall and winter months looking at various reading programs to pilot and/ or adopt for the 2023-24 school year and six (6) initial programs were brought up by teachers. She reviewed the criteria that ensure that we align with State expectations and other details. Ms. Desrochers welcomes any feedback on the proposed program.

Superintendent Ambrose said there is a difference of opinion from teachers on what program they prefer, so veteran teachers are being asked to help interpret they whys and why-nots of their choices.

Discussion ensued.

<u>Public Comment:</u> Dr. Brown said: As a teacher. We went through the same thing. It is like herding cats. You have to do something new, and the teachers say, "Well I have this procedure for assessment, and I want to see if this one's working, why do I need this one". I want to ask you instead of the 30,000-foot view, about the 100,000-foot views on the budget committee, which is where I am now, I'm just wondering if we're going to get an update on our targets, our academic targets for Math and English in our strategic plan? Does it involve meeting goals? How are we doing that?
