Daniel J. Bakie School KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION for Newton and Kingston, NH

If your child will be five years old by September 30, 2020 and you are a <u>resident of</u>
<u>Kingston, or Newton, NH</u>, he or she should register for full day kindergarten for the 2020-2021 school year. Please go to our website at http://www.sau17.org/3/home and click on the kindergarten registration link to provide us with your child's information and to schedule a screening. All incoming kindergarten students are required to participate in a screening process. Student screenings will take place on Thursday, April 9th and Friday April 10th.

Registration packets will be available to pick up at the school *when you present your child's original birth certificate* on Monday, March 2nd. Additional documentation required to complete the registration process includes a current physical & immunization record and proof of residency documentations. The Sanborn Regional School District has defined the following acceptable residency documents: a copy of a current utility bill (electric, cable, gas, oil) showing your name and address (no P.O. Boxes), along with either a signed lease, notarized letter from Builder or Realtor, property tax bill, settlement document on a new home or a property deed. We ask that registration be completed *no later than June 1st*.

New Hampshire State Law requires all children to have had immunizations for DPT, Polio, Mumps, Measles, German Measles, Chicken Pox, and Hepatitis B prior to entry to school. They also require each child to have a complete medical examination within one year prior to entry into kindergarten.

An orientation and information night for parents of incoming kindergarten students will take place on Thursday, March 12, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. at the D. J. Bakie School. Please mark your calendars. This evening is designed for parents/guardians only please.
