Daniel J. Bakie School **KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION** **for Newton and Kingston, NH**

If your child will be five years old by September 30, 2020 and you are a ***resident of Kingston, or Newton, NH***, he or she should register for full day kindergarten for the 2020-2021 school year. **Please go to our website at <http://www.sau17.org/3/home> and click on the kindergarten registration link to provide us with your child's information and to schedule a screening.** All incoming kindergarten students are required to participate in a screening process. Student screenings will take place on **Thursday, April 9th and Friday April 10th.**

Registration packets will be available to pick up at the school ***when you present your child's original birth certificate*** on Monday, March 2nd. Additional documentation required to complete the registration process includes a current physical & immunization record and proof of residency documentations. The Sanborn Regional School District has defined the following acceptable residency documents: a copy of a current utility bill (electric, cable, gas, oil) showing your name and address (no P.O. Boxes), along with either a signed lease, notarized letter from Builder or Realtor, property tax bill, settlement document on a new home or a property deed. We ask that registration be completed ***no later than June 1st.***

New Hampshire State Law requires all children to have had immunizations for DPT, Polio, Mumps, Measles, German Measles, Chicken Pox, and Hepatitis B prior to entry to school. They also require each child to have a complete medical examination within one year prior to entry into kindergarten.

An orientation and information night for parents of incoming kindergarten students will take place on **Thursday, March 12, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. at the D. J. Bakie School. Please mark your calendars. This evening is designed for parents/guardians only please.**
