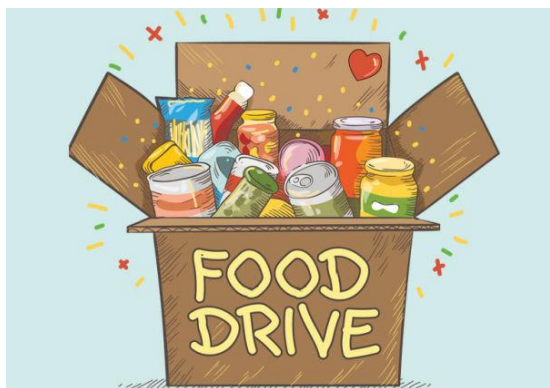
Sign Up for Text Messages from Memorial School
